



## Recommended Markup Tools





- **Every markup that is made to a PDF will be recorded on the Markup List**
  - **List can be found Bottom Panel of Desktop App & Right Panel of Web App**
- **Users may search the list in both the Desktop App & Web App**
- **Additional features are available such as filter and sorting of the list with the Desktop App**
- **To Provide Response to the Comment – Users are to Reply to each Comment directly within the Bluebeam Studio Session**
  - **Desktop App – Right click on Comment and Select Reply, then type response**
  - **Web App – Left Click on Comment, this will open an dialog box. Type comment and hit the send icon**






- **Changing Status of a Markup**
